

# Singing Etiquette for the Dining Hall

- Songs except for those from the “Songs for Every Occasion” section of the song book may only be started by seniors.
- Once a song has been sung at a meal, it should not be sung again until at least the next meal.
- When starting a song, make sure you have enough people to start with you to be heard.
- If you start a song, you should continue singing until the end. Don’t expect others to continue it for you.
- Before you start a song, listen to make sure no one else is already singing.
- DON’T start songs over other songs.
- Once a song has been taken to the cemetery, it cannot be sung again for at least three meals.

When songs are being sung on Sundays, if you are not singing, you should be quiet so the songs can be heard.
