Scotch Pine Commitment

(to be signed by all Scotch Pines in addition to their Community Commitment)

As a member of the oldest age group in camp, every Scotch Pine assumes an important leadership role at Waukeela. Whether or not she is captain of a team or sits on Camper Council and whether or not she thinks about herself in this way, each Scotch Pine is a role model whose behaviors are closely observed by younger campers.

I understand that:

Other campers will naturally look to me as a leader. Accordingly, I will model positive behavior and speech for them to follow at all times.

Living in a large cabin is different from the smaller cabins I am used to at camp, and this usually means that the group dynamics in the cabin are more complicated. I will respect the needs and desires of everyone I will be living with, and I am willing to work through any issues which come up between us.

Camp does not ask me to be happy all of the time. But it does expect that I will not pull others down with me when I feel negatively about somebody or something.

Showing respect for all staff members, and the policies and rules which they enforce as part of their job, is a critical feature of the Waukeela community. If I do not understand or agree with an action or decision, I will talk privately with a member of the Senior Staff rather than complain in front of or to other campers.
